A shining example of our partnership is the establishment of the Habitat Bucks land trust model in 2022. This model has been a true game changer in making sure there will be affordable housing in the long-term. Habitat Bucks is ensuring that vital members of our communities, such as school teachers and social workers, are not priced out of the neighborhoods they serve.
